The community team are open to every young person aged between 11-19 in Gwynedd; We work in all communities. We offer different types of educational experiences through fun activities — during evenings, weekends, and at residentials — out of school hours.

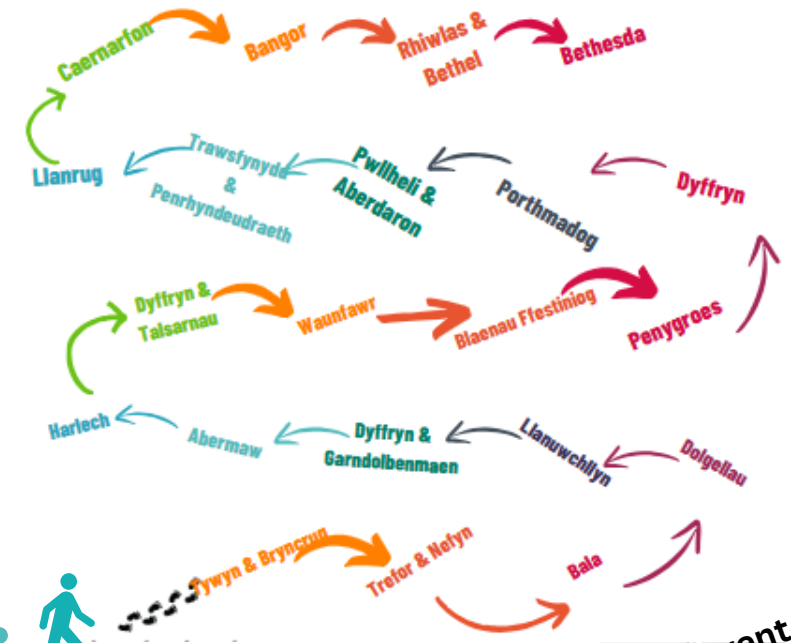
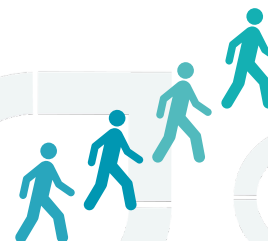
